

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENACT ORDINANCE

NOTICE is hereby given that the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors will consider for enactment, the following Ordinance at a regular meeting to be held on Monday, May 12, 2014, at the Franklin Township Building, 897 State Route 288, Fombell, Pennsylvania 16123, at 6:00 P.M.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN BEAVER COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA, PROHIBITING PARKING ON  
TOWNSHIP STREETS DURING WINTER MONTHS

**WHEREAS**, Townships of the Second Class are authorized to regulate parking on Township streets pursuant to Section 2328 of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S., § 67328; and

**WHEREAS**, in the interest of public safety, Franklin Township plows the snow from Township roads and streets during the winter months; and

**WHEREAS**, parking on Township streets during the winter months impedes the removal of snow on Township streets thereby creating a public safety hazard;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Franklin Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

1     Prohibition of Parking. Parking is hereby prohibited on all Township roads or streets from November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup> each year.


2     Penalties for Enforcement. This Ordinance shall be enforced by action brought before a District Justice in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure. Fines will be \$25.00 per violation and each day that the violation continues following notice shall be a separate offense. For each repeat offense in the same winter season, the fine will increase by an additional \$25.00. After the third offense in the same winter season, the illegally parked vehicle shall be towed to a designated impoundment area and the owner shall be liable, in addition to the fine, for the cost of towing and storage. All fines collected for the violation of this Ordinance shall be paid to the Township Treasurer.

3.     Enforcement of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Township Supervisors and also by the Franklin Township Police Chief and the Franklin Township Solicitor as required. The cost of enforcing the Ordinance shall be added to the fine if not paid within the time prescribed by the notice.
