

Chapter 3  
Part 1  
Dumping of Garbage

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Franklin, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That no person or persons, firm, partnership, or corporation shall at any time dump or otherwise deposit any garbage or rubbish within the limits of said Township or Franklin, in the County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, unless at some place specifically designated by said Supervisors.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons, firm, partnership or corporation found guilty by a Justice of the Peace for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined a sum not in excess of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each and every offense, and in default of the payment of the fine and costs, the defendent may be sentenced and committed to the Township lockup for a period not exceeding five (5) days or to the County Jail for a period not exceeding fifteen (15) days, at the discretion of the Justice of the Peace hearing such case. Each and every day that any garbage or rubbish is dumped or otherwise deposited in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance, and shall be subject to separate and distinct penalties thereunder.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
