Information

The medication collection and disposal program provides a safe disposal location for citizens to properly dispose of unused prescription and over the counter medications.

- This program provides an environmentally safe alternative to disposing the medications in the landfill or sewer systems which may later negatively affect the environment.
- This program encourages citizens to remove their unneeded medications from their homes. This reduces access to addictive medications for accidental or intentional misuse
- Citizens may place their unused medications into the collection box anonymously.
- Medications should remain in their original containers. Personal information on the labels should be crossed out, but information about the medication should be legible.
- Syringes should not be placed in the drop box.
- Open containers of liquid will not be accepted unless they are completely sealed.

How to dispose of syringes

- Syringes (needles/sharps) can be disposed of at Heritage Valley Beaver located at 1000 Dutch Ridge Road, Beaver, PA 15009. Once you go in the main entrance of the hospital, take Elevator B to Floor 2. Exit the elevator and proceed to the Housekeeping Department, where they will take your used syringes.
- Place all used syringes in a plastic or metal container, which can be secured tightly with a lid and heavy duty tape.

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM THE "GRANDPARENT SCAM"

You get a call or an email unexpectedly from someone who claims to be a friend or relative. This often happens to grandparents with the caller claiming to be their grandson or granddaughter. The caller says there's an emergency and asks you to send money immediately. But beware, there's a good chance this is an imposter trying to steal your money.

If you get a call or email from someone claiming to know you and asking for help, check to confirm that it's legitimate before you send any money. Ask some questions that would be hard for an imposter to answer correctly – the name of the person's pet, for example, or the date of their mother's birthday. Contact the person who they claim to be directly. If you can't reach the person, contact someone else – a friend or relative of the person. Don't send money unless you're sure it's the real person you know.
