The seasons are changing and with the approach of colder weather I would like to remind everyone to be aware of the increased fire danger. First there is the issue with open burning with all the dry leaves and brush that surround our homes. It doesn't take much wind to move a fire quickly across an open space. It is particularly dangerous to burn leaves or brush near any structure. Please be sure to attend any open fire and call immediately if you feel the fire is out of your control.

The next real danger comes with home heating. As the cold weather sets in many of us use auxiliary devices to keep our homes warm. Please use caution operating such devices. Kerosene and electric heaters should be clear of any combustible materials. Fireplace chimneys should be inspected and cleaned before they are used. A crack in a chimney lining can lead to an increased hazard of a fire in the home. I would like to remind everyone the fire department is available any time you need us. Please don't be afraid to call if you feel you have a problem. Our firefighters would rather come to your home and check out a perceived problem instead of having battle an actual fire. Please remember smoke detectors save lives. Please change the batteries annually and if you need a detector contact the fire department.
